At Chatten Free School, we are committed to providing all our students, with access to a range of career pathway opportunities. In line with the Provider Access Legislation, we aim to deliver meaningful encounters, where appropriate and relevant, with technical education and work experience providers and other progression routes (Local Offer) that are carefully tailored to meet the diverse needs of our students. **Student Entitlement**

Students at Chatten Free School, regardless of their individual abilities, are entitled to:

A minimum of six meaningful encounters, where appropriate and relevant, with technical education, apprenticeship providers or other appropriate providers between Years 8 and 14.

Two encounters in each key phase:

- **Years 8–9:** To introduce career-related possibilities in accessible formats.
- **Years 10–11:** To support informed decision-making and transition planning.
- **Years 12–14:** To explore further education, employment pathways, and opportunities suited to everyone's strengths and aspirations.

Our Commitment to Differentiation

To ensure accessibility for students with SLD, we provide:

- **Sensory-Based Experiences:** For students with SLD, we offer encounters that focus on sensory engagement, such as tactile resources, visual presentations, and sensory-friendly environments. These activities aim to raise awareness of pathways in a manner that is meaningful to the individual.
- **Simplified, Structured Sessions:** For students with SLD, we organise encounters that use simple language, clear visuals, and practical, structured activities. This helps to make career-related information more understandable and relatable.
- **One-to-One Support:** Where needed, students are supported by familiar staff members who can help facilitate their understanding and engagement during sessions.
- **Parent and Carer Involvement:** We recognise the importance of involving families in the process. We provide resources and opportunities for parents/carers to engage with providers and gain insights into career pathways for their child.
